GUIDANCE – WIRELESS PORT

1. Deactivation (LAN Access Point Mode)
(Warning- Deactivation removes the Wireless connection between the printer and the Network's access point; (re)activation is accomplished using a USB connection between the printer and computer)
 - Deactivation can be accomplished using a web browser on a computer connected to the same network.
 - Enter the CWIS Web application by typing the printer's LAN IP address in a web browser's address line.
 - Choose the 'Properties' tab or 'Properties' from the side menu.
 - Login to the Account 'Admin' with the default password of 1111 or the password you created.
 - Choose "Network Settings" and then "WiFi" from the side menu
 - Toggle the Enable Check in the main display area.
 - Verify your intention because this will disable Wifi on the printer and the wireless connection you have to it.
2. Activation
 - Activation can be accomplished by connecting to the printer from your computer via a USB cable.
 - From the Start Menu go to All Programs, Xerox Printer, Xerox Easy Wireless Setup.
 - Select the wireless network you want the Xerox device to connect to.
 - Enter the network password and select next.
 - Activation is confirmed with the 'Setup Complete' display
